Irrigation Short Certificate

The irrigation industry is experiencing a period of rapid technological advancement in labor saving and water conserving irrigation components, including pipes, sprinklers, sensors and controllers. In communities throughout the country, irrigation technicians are required to design, install, operate and maintain these new products to keep gardens, parks and golf courses healthy and green. Irrigation technicians also work with people, such as property managers or owners to ensure the proper coordination of activities.

This short certification focuses specifically on building hands-on skills in turf irrigation components and controls, design, installation, and troubleshooting. The winter quarter course can be taken either online or in person at Walla Walla Community College. The spring quarter course can only be taken online and students must be employed in the industry, as coursework will include submission of short cell phone videos demonstrating troubleshooting skills and repair work. Washington residents may be eligible for worker retraining funds to cover the costs of tuition.
